



# VOLUNTEER TRUSTEES NEEDED FOR BISHOP'S STORTFORD COMMUNITY TRANSPORT

Our charity supplies transport for many vulnerable and socially isolated people. It is responsible for the much loved Stortford Shuttle, a community bus service that helps many elderly, special needs, people with learning difficulties and other local residents get out- and-about. Stortford Shuttle enables these people to stay connected with the community and access shops and the vital healthcare services etc they need. Stortford Shuttle operates on a registered route and also serves local nursing/retirement homes, Bishop's Stortford Day Service and Herts & Essex Hospital.

In addition to the regular services we also offer an affordable self-drive minibus hire service that assists local charities/not-for-profit groups like the New Apton Centre, Age Concern etc. Bishop's Stortford Town Council assists us by way of managing the Stortford Shuttle service and self-drive hire service for us on our behalf.

The Trustees of Bishop's Stortford Community Transport CIO are all volunteers and currently meet for board meetings 4 times a year, these meetings are no longer than 2hrs and are usually online via MSTeam with the one meeting being in person face-to-face per year.

This is an opportunity for you to make a real difference in people's lives and your local community.
