ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 ORDER UNDER SECTION 16 (A)

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES DURING THE 'BISHOPS STORTFORD CHRISTMAS FAYRE') ORDER 2023

The Hertfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Temporary Traffic Management Measures during the 'Bishops Stortford Christmas Fayre') Order 2023" and shall come into operation between the hours of 6.00am and 7.00pm on Saturday 2 December 2023, when signs are in place.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to Fire and Rescue, Police and Ambulance Service vehicles during the course of an emergency.
- 3. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of B1529 North Street, Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1004 High Street north westwards to its junction with A1250 Hadham Road, a distance of approximately 190 metres, except for access.
 - An alternative route will be via B1004 (High Street/Windhill/Great Hadham Road), A1184 Bishops Park Way and A1250 Hadham Road.
- 4. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of B1004 High Street, Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1529 North Street south westwards to its junction with Basbow Lane, a distance of approximately 65 metres, except for access.
 - An alternative route will be via B1004 (High Street/Windhill/Great Hadham Road), A1184 Bishops Park Way and A1250 Hadham Road
- 5. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of B1529 (South Street/Potter Street/Market Street), Bishops Stortford from its junction with A1059 Station Road north westwards to its junction with Bridge Street, a distance of approximately 392 metres, except for access.
 - An alternative route will be via A1059 Station Road, Riverside, Adderley Road and A1250 (The Causeway/Link Road/Hadham Road)
- 6. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of Apton Road, Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1529 Potter Street south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with the Scott Road/Jervis Road roundabout, a distance of approximately 595 metres, except for access.
 - There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.
- 7. All vehicular traffic is prohibited from using that length of Palmers Lane, Bishops Stortford from its junction with Bridge Street south eastwards for its entire length, except for access.
 - There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.

- 8. All vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes (mgw) are prohibited from using that length of Apton Road, Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1529 Potter Street south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with the Scott Road/Jervis Road roundabout, a distance of approximately 595 metres.
- 9. All vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes (mgw) are prohibited from using that length of Church Street, Bishops Storford from its junction with B1529 Potter Street south westwards and north westwards to its junction with B1004 High Street, a distance of approximately 224 metres.
- 10. All vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes (mgw) are prohibited from using that length of Newtown Road, Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1529 South Street south westwards to its junction with Apton Road, a distance of approximately 595 metres.
- 11. All vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes (mgw) are prohibited from using that length of Water Lane. Bishops Stortford from its junction with B1529 North Street north eastwards and south eastwards to its junction with Bridge Street, a distance of approximately 230 metres.
- 12. All vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes (mgw) are prohibited from using that length of Barrett Lane, Bishops Stortford from its junction with Water Lane south westwards to its junction with B1529 North Street, a distance of approximately 73 metres.
- 13. All vehicles are prohibited from making a left turn manoeuvre from Newtown Road into B1529 South Street, Bishops Stortford, when signs are in place.
- 14. The provisions of 'The County Council of Hertfordshire (Traffic Regulation No.2B) Order, 1948' insofar as it relates to the one way traffic system on Church Street, Bishops Storford from its junction with B1529 Potter Street south westwards and north westwards to its junction with B1004 High Street, a distance of approximately 224 metres will be temporarily suspended, when the one way traffic signs are covered, to enable all vehicles to travel in both directions within this length of road for the duration of the event.
- 15. The provisions of 'East Hertfordshire District Council (Water Lane and Barretts Lane, Bishops Stortford) (One Way Traffic) Order (No.54) 1980' will be temporarily suspended, when the one way traffic signs are covered, to enable all vehicles to travel in both directions within these lengths of roads, for the duration of the event.
- The provisions of 'The Hertfordshire (Newtown Road, Bishop's Stortford) (Prescribed Routes) 16. Order 2006' will be temporarily suspended, when the existing traffic signs are covered, to enable vehicles proceeding eastwards along this road to turn right into B1529 South Street and proceed straight into A1059 Station Road, for the duration of the event.
- 17. In making this Order, the Hertfordshire County Council is satisfied that the traffic management measures are required to ensure public safety and prevent accidents whilst the 'Bishops Stortford Christmas Fayre' event takes place.
