

Laying to rest of ashes in a New Grave.

Please ring the Cemetery administrator 01279 712418 in the first instance.

You will need to have with you the following details:

The name and address of the deceased, the address at which death occurred and the date and age at time of death.

Your name, address, contact number and relationship to the deceased.

The name address and contact number of the person to whom the new Exclusive Right of Burial Deed should be made out to. (BSTC recommends that an adult child of the deceased becomes the Registered Owner if possible)

Are the ashes to be laid to rest in the Old Cemetery or the New Cemetery? If the ashes are to be laid to rest in the New Cemetery will it be in the small headstone area or the tablet area?

The name of the Cremation Authority, Certificate number, date of Cremation and size and type of ashes container.

Possible dates and times for the laying to rest and if a minister will be present.

Would the use of the Chapel be required? (Dependent on Covid restrictions)

Please note

If the deceased was a BSTC resident at the time of their death they will be charged at the resident rate. Currently the charges for 2021/2022 are £350 for the Exclusive Burial Deed, £210 for the interment and £55 for the admin fee.

If the deceased was not a BSTC resident at the time of their death, had they lived in BS for at least 5 years within the last 20 years? If yes, the charge will be at the previous resident rate. Currently the charges for 2021/2022 are £630 for the Exclusive Burial Deed, £380 for the interment and £55 for the admin fee.

If the deceased was not a BSTC resident at the time of their death, and had not lived BS for at least 5 years within the last 20 years, the charge will be at the non-resident rate. Currently the charges for 2021/2022 are £1050 for the Exclusive Burial Deed, £630 for the interment and £55 for the admin fee.
