

Organising the Laying to Rest of Ashes in the Memorial Garden (Path)

In the Old Cemetery with the Town Council

Please ring the Cemetery administrators on 01279 712148 or 01279 715003 in the first instance.

You will need to have with you the following details:

The name and address of the deceased, the address at which death occurred and the date and age at time of death.

Your name, address, contact number and relationship to the deceased.

The name of the Cremation Authority, Certificate number and date of Cremation. Please note ashes may only be laid to rest by scattering loose in a section of the garden of your choosing.

Possible dates and times for the laying to rest and if a minister will be present.

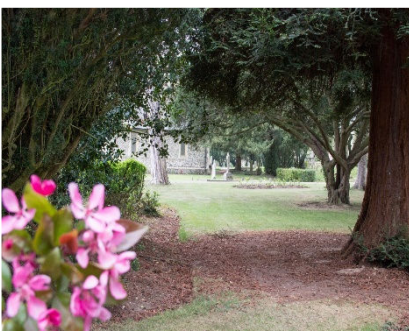
The cost for this service is £155.00 which includes the addition of the details of the deceased being held on our database.

The Scattering

On the chosen day and time of the scattering the family will be able to scatter the ashes privately. It is recommended that an area of the bark covering is pushed aside for the scattering and that the ashes are covered over on completion. The Town Council does not organise a marker for the area where the scattering has taken place, but this can be arranged by the family if they choose.

Memorial Plaque on Bench

Subject to availability, it may be possible to have a memorial plaque added to the bench in the Memorial Garden for 10 years. The cost for this would be £465.00 including VAT for a 20cm x 5cm plaque and maximum of 50 letters and numbers.
